1.1 Chairman

1.1.1 Mr Gilmour opened the meeting by introducing the committee and welcoming all club

1.2 League Secretary

1.4.1 Mr Moore reported that the under 18 fixtures were done and that the Knock Out Cup

1.8 Under 21 Registrar

1.8.1 Mr Gilmour reported that he was receiving a steady flow of registrations, but asked clubs to send in their registrations as soon as possible.

1.9.1 Mr Beynon reported the balance in the Meadowhall League Account at the time of the amalgamation.

1.9.2 Mr Skelton reported that balances in the DB Sports Accounts had been advised at their final AGM in June.

1.9.3 Mr Skelton reported that a donation of £1,000.00 would be made to the Sheffield Childrens Hospital – Helipad Appeal.

1.9.4 Mr Skelton reported that each team would receive a voucher for £50.00 to be redeemed at DB Sports.

1.9.4 Mr Skelton reported that work was ongoing to amalgamate the DB Sports Accounts into the Meadowhall League Accounts but was unlikely to be completed before the end of October.
