Postponement requests to be made to Denise on postponement request form which is available to download on League website and FA Fulltime.</p> <p>The League is sanctioned to play on Sundays only, if you would like to play a midweek fixture please send details to Denise who will request permission from the CFA, when permission has been granted Denise will inform Club Secretaries and the fixture will be updated on Fulltime</p> <p>Midweek fixtures must be played on a Tuesday/Thursday</p>
